11 GCBC members and 7 guests birded Lake Conestee Nature Park LCNP). 6 of us started at the overlook on Spanco Drive at 7 a.m. before going to the trailhead at the Belmont FD to meet the rest of the group at 8 a.m. In that way we were able to get an early start on the new paved lakeside trail which is proving to be the "birdiest" trail in the park.

4 of our guests were first time birders and mid-July is not the best time of the year to see birds. However, we did see a few and heard a good many more.

The morning's total of 51 species was a record for any single day in July since we started keeping bird records in LCNP in December 2006. The birding highlights were Great Egrets (3), an immature Black-crowned Night Heron, a Yellow-billed Cuckoo, Northern Parulas (2), a Black and White Warbler, and a male Scarlet Tanager (in intermediate breeding / non-breeding plumage showing large patches of yellow in several places).

Given the success on the new paved trail, all future GCBC outings to LCNP will start at the trailhead at the overlook on Spanco Drive near the dam in Conestee village.
