Greenville County Bird Club Trip Report

Comments:

10 GCBC members enjoyed an excellent morning's birding at Conestee. We started by doing the East Bay loop and found 9 duck species including 3 Am. Black Ducks, 3 Green-winged Teal, 3 Am. Wigeon and a single female N. Pintail.

We then carpooled to the Spanco trail-head and birded the trails back to the cars.

We did not bird the entire blue trail loop because the recent heavy rain had left parts of the trail very muddy and slick.

The best bird of the day may have been the male Common Yellowthroat spotted by Jane Kramer along the blue trail not far from the West Bay observation deck. This was a first for any month of January and now Common Yellowthroats have been reported at LCNP in every month of the year.

In all we reported 56 species. This was augmented to 57 when a Cooper's Hawk was spotted by Steve Compton as he drove out of the parking lot at Spanco.

Later, Brad Dalton reported 4 Winter Wrens in the East Bay when he went there to look for the recently arrived ducks. (He was unsuccessful.)

We raised this month's species list to 71, a new January record.
