assembling there were taking part in a 6K race! Even though

a race monitor assured me that the race would not go through the "birding area" (I told her that's the entire park) we decided to carpool to Spanco Drive and start birding there. We birded our way back to the stadium and covered most of the trails. The trail system in the park is now so extensive that it's impossible to cover all the trails in one morning. We reported 50 species, a good count for mid-November, but, unfortunately, the American Bittern staved out of sight (it was seen again a couple of days later) and we saw no Rusty Blackbirds. I had reported 200+ earlier in the week. The bird list follows. The highlights were a Double-Crested Cormorant flying over the park (the first ever in November) and a Fox Sparrow, next to the trail close to the East Bay. The Fox Sparrow was the first of the season.
