We listed 56 species. The highlights were a Blackpoll Warbler near the Spanco trailhead, a Prairie Warbler (heard but not seen) near the ball-fields, young Redshouldered Hawks in both nests, very vocal young Great Blue Herons in at least 3 of the 4 nests, and a juvenile Double-crested Cormorant, which has now been on the East Bay lake

for several weeks.
