Sunday morning found us back at Savannah NWR for one last visit before heading home. Part of our group spent the afternoon birding at the Bluff Unit of Santee NWR on Lake Marion.

I hope everone enjoyed this outing as much as I did. We managed a very respectable list of 117 species.
