14 GCBC members and 1 guest participated in the outing. The farms around Townville yielded the expected sparrow species, including Vesper and White-crowned, as well as an American Pipit, although the wind tended to keep the birds low to the ground.

We were fortunate to spot 2 coyotes, also keeping pretty low as they moved among the cattle.

The pond at Dobbins Farm turned up 6 American Wigeon, several Mallards and 20 + Green-winged Teal.

The color of the fall leaves made the Beavercreek Dam WMA beautiful but, unfortunately, there were not many birds to be seen or heard.

The very low lake levels were such that a stretch of Lake Hartwell carried a few Canada Geese but no ducks. Shorebirds were also few in numbers: a few Killdeer, a couple of Lesser Yellowlegs, one or two Wilson's Snipe and a small group of Western Sandpipers. Many docks and boats were high and dry and a long way from any water!

The total species count was 56.
