Comments: On January 14 the GCBC held our annual Lakes of Greenville

County outing. Nineteen members & guests started the very

cold but calm morning at Lake Cunningham where we

observed large groups of Ring-billed Gulls along with several Herring Gulls flying over on their way to the Welford landfill. We also saw Rusty Blackbirds along with more common species. At Berry's Millpond we found decent numbers of waterfowl including Mallard, Wood Duck, G-w Teal, R-n Duck and Bufflehead. We found Swamp Sparrows, Hermit Thrush, R-c Kinglet, G-c Kinglet and a very bright Pine Warbler along with other common birds at the old fish hatchery. Our next stop was Lake Robinson where we found

the P-b Grebe and a Cooper's Hawk. Our last stop was the wetland at the upper end of Lake Robinson where we found

the A. Wigeon and A. Black Duck.
