Greenville County Bird Club Trip Report

Date: February 4, 2012

American White Pelican

Location: Santee National Wildlife Refuge

Leader: Susie Heisey

Susie Heisey, a ranger at Santee National Wildlife Refuge, led a group of 30 birders through several areas of the Refuge. We started at the Bluff Unit, where we spotted Sandhill Cranes, several species of ducks, Bald Eagles and other raptors, American Pipits, and various other birds in the fields and impoundments. On the Wright's Bluff Nature Trail, we found Orange-crowned and Black-and-white Warblers as well as Blue-headed Vireo, and some of the group was treated to a daylight look at a Barred Owl.

After lunch at the Visitor Center, we moved on to the Cuddo Unit. At Cuddo West, we found more ducks, an Anhinga, a Northern Harrier, and a group of feral pigs. As we continued around Cuddo East, we saw Bonaparte's Gulls, Forster's Terns, Horned Grebes, and some very large alligators.

Later in the afternoon, a smaller group of birders continued back to the Cuddo Unit to spot a group of over 50 White Pelicans that had been reported, and then went to the Pine Island Unit of the Refuge to look for sparrows. We were rewarded with a very cooperative Le Conte's Sparrow, which was relocated the next morning by a group who camped in the area overnight.

Special thanks are due to Susie for leading our group, showing us into areas to which we would not otherwise have had access, and handling a very large group with grace.
