Comments: Today, January 12th, the Greenville County Bird Club held

its annual outing to the lakes of northern Greenville County. Fourteen members and guests tallied sixty-two species on an unseasonably warm day with temperatures reaching seventy degrees. The day started with a raft of Redheads at Lake Cunningham and hundreds of gulls flying high overhead that were seen by a few members of the group as we awaited everyone's arrival. At Berry's Mill Pond, we found eleven species of waterfowl including an American Black Duck as well as a small flock of Pine Siskins and a Fox Sparrow. Winter Wrens were seen and heard throughout the morning, and at Lake Robinson we were able to get a good look at a pair of Horned Grebes diving for lunch. Our final species for the day was a Hairy Woodpecker that was calling as Redtailed Hawks circled above at the wetlands at the northern end of Lake Robinson.
