Greenville County Bird Club Trip Report

Date: February 2 – 3, 2013

Location: Santee National Wildlife Refuge **Leaders:** Susie Heisey and Irvin Pitts

Susie Heisey and Irvin Pitts led a group of 15 birders through the Bluff Unit of Santee National Wildlife Refuge. We started at the Bluff Unit, where we spotted Sandhill Cranes, a dozen species of ducks, Common Gallinule, and several species of raptors among the fields and impoundments. On the Wright's Bluff Nature Trail, we found Orange-crowned and Black-and-white Warblers, Blue-headed Vireo, Winter Wrens, Hermit Thrushes, Blue-Gray Gnatcatcher, Red-breasted Nuthatches, and Brown Creepers, among others. Near the Indian Mound, we also picked up a Yellow-throated Warbler.

After lunch at the Visitor Center, some of the group moved on to the Cuddo East Unit, where we again found a nice variety, including White Pelicans, Anhinga, and Sedge Wren.

On the way back to the Upstate, a pair of birders stopped back by the Bluff Unit and found Tundra Swans, while another group closed out the evening at Cuddo, watching evening flights of huge numbers of Great Egrets and various blackbirds.

On Sunday, a smaller group of birders started the day by relocating the Tundra Swans that had been spotted the previous day, then moving on to the Pine Island Unit. While we were unable to find a Le Conte's or Henslow's Sparrow, we were rewarded with a Peregrine Falcon, a Loggerhead Shrike, and several of the other good birds that had been seen earlier in the trip.

Special thanks are due to Susie and Irvin for leading the group. For the second year, Susie generously showed us into areas to which we would not otherwise have had access.

We had a great trip, finishing with 104 species! The full list is below.
