Greenville County Bird Club Trip Report

Comments:

Only one other GCBC member showed up for the outing on a cold but bright morning. Fortunately, we had 4 non-members with us, one of whom lives on the Outer Banks, NC. We started by doing the East Bay loop and found a variety of duck species: N. Shovelers, Ring-necked Ducks, Gadwall, Ruddy Duck, Mallard, and the first Blue-winged Teal of the month, a beautifully marked male.

While at the observation deck we observed a pair of Red-shouldered Hawks mating. We then carpooled to the Spanco trail-head and birded the trails back to the cars. In all we reported 46 species. Unfortunately, we did not see any Rusty Blackbirds which would have been a life-bird for some of the non-members.

Brad Dalton birded part of the Swamp rabbit Trail a little later than the main group and saw an estimated 120 Rusties along the side of Crescent Slough. It has been reported on several occasions recently that the birds show up there late morning and we were too early! Brad said that they were very vocal and they definitely were NOT there when the main group passed that spot an hour earlier.

The list which follows is a combination of the group's and Brad's lists. We raised this month's species list to 74, a new February record.
