Four club members and two guests had a beautiful day of birding with a day's count of 61 species. The day started with a Louisiana Waterthrush in the middle of Preston McDaniel Road, an omen of the 16 warblers that ended up on today's list. We had good looks at a Magnolia Warbler and heard the call of a Yellow-billed Cuckoo at Nine Times Preserve, where Tim Taylor identified a Red Eft, the juvenile stage of the Eastern Newt.

Eastatoe Valley gave us some very vocal Chats and some interesting warbler voices to track down (we really missed Jeff). At Sassafras Mountain, Jane was able to discover the continuous chip in the Rhododendron belonged to a female Hooded Warbler. A great spring day in Pickens County! The full list follows.
