## **Greenville County Bird Club Trip Report**

Date: September 7, 2013

Location: Jackson Park and Hooper Lane

Thirteen birders enjoyed a nice morning of birding at Jackson Park in Hendersonville, NC. While there were periods when the birding was slow, we had enough mixed flocks of migrants and good company to keep us entertained for the morning. We finished with thirteen species of warblers at Jackson Park, and also found a couple of Empidonax flycatchers.

After an enjoyable meal at Papas & Beer, the Mexican restaurant that has become our tradition, some of us continued to Hooper Lane for a brief visit. Although it was pretty dry and there were very few shorebirds there, two great ones did make a showing for us, with a group of fourteen American Golden Plovers and three Buff-breasted Sandpipers both within easy viewing distance.
