Greenville County Bird Club Trip Report

Date: May 30, 2015

Location: Brevard and the Blue Ridge Parkway south of Asheville

Six GCBC members enjoyed a beautiful day of birding in the Brevard area and along the Blue Ridge Parkway. Our first stop was the "Hospital Fields" near Brevard. Our next three stops were along US Highway 276 at Sycamore Flats picnic area, the fish hatchery, and Buck Spring trailhead. The remainder of the day was spent along the Blue Ridge Parkway beginning at the Mt Pisgah trailhead, lunch at Mt Pisgah picnic area, Black Balsam (Shining Rock) and finally at Devil's Courthouse.

We had a very decent list of 53 species, with the best birds being Swainson's Warbler and Louisiana Waterthrush seen together along the stream at the fish hatchery. After hearing the Swainson's, I played its song and to our surprise a Louisiana Waterthrush flew in with the Swainson's. At Black Balsam we had a very cooperative Alder Flycatcher which was seen then heard. We also had excellent looks at Blue-headed Vireo, Black-throated Blue Warbler and numerous Chestnut-sided Warblers. The list follows.
