## **Greenville County Bird Club Trip Report**

A dozen GCBC members enjoyed a beautiful day of birding in the Townville area on Saturday, November 14. After gather the group, we started at the ponds at Dobbins Farm, where we had the first of a nice variety of raptors in the form of a first-year Bald Eagle, which stayed perched nicely in view our entire time at the ponds. We also had an Osprey and a young Red-shouldered Hawk at the same location.

On the ponds, the highlights were a single male Bufflehead, a few sleeping Ruddy Ducks, and a quick fly-by of some Green-winged Teal. As is usually the case, Savannah Sparrows and Meadowlarks were prevalent, and we had a few fly-overs of American Pipits. At one point, we heard Horned Lark singing, but could not locate it.

At Beaverdam Creek WMA and the nearby road, we had a nice variety of woodpeckers and sparrows. The bridge at Fork School Road was pretty quiet, however, so we moved on to Prater Farm. There we found White-crowned and Vesper Sparrows, as well as a nice Northern Harrier and an American Kestrel.

As always, Townville made for a really nice day of birding. The list is below.
