**Rusty Blackbird 85** Counted 85 individuals in trees opposite the Spanco parking lot. Mix of females (brown and gray, bright eye) and males (darker than females, some black, with bright yellow eye). ALL were RUBL - no RWBL in the mix. A lot of these birds flew down to foarage in the marsh next to the short boardwalk close to Spanco, affording excellent looks at short distance. There were probably Rusties already in the marsh and so I consider 85 to be a conservative count. There were probably in excess of 100 present.
