The club's annual trek to Allendale was hot! In the middle of a week long run of temperatures pushing triple digits we had a 6 intrepid travelers looking for Swallow-tailed Kites. The sight of these amazing fliers is always worth the trip! The Kite fields at Millet Road delivered with 60 Swallow-tailed and 20 Mississippi Kites, we watched for almost an hour before we retreated to the air conditioned vehicles and searched for some shade. Along with our other Allendale stops, Furse Mill Pond and the area South of Allendale we had Red-headed Woodpecker, a large group of Cattle Egret, Loggerhead Shrike and Anhinga.





From there our group split up and three members went on to explore Aiken Gopher Tortoise Heritage Preserve. They had a good afternoon and managed to spot a Bachman's Sparrow!

On Sunday two of us continued to Bear Island and Donnelley WMA. We had a good day with 4 sightings of Least Bittern, 7 species of Heron including Black-crowned Night Heron and 3 species of Swallows including Bank. We also found an immature Purple Gallinule and ended the day at Donnelley by watching a Wood Stork rookery.
