## **Greenville County Bird Club Trip Report**

## Regular (Longer) Walk

8 GCBC members and 2 guests participated in some or all of the longer outing at Conestee this morning. The highlight was watching a pair of Prothonotary Warblers feeding young in one of the nestboxes Dave hargett put up a few years ago. To the best of my knowledge this is the first year that we have conclusive evidence of Prothonotaries successfully nesting at Conestee.

A female Hooded Merganser in the East Bay is the first of this species reported at Conestee in any month of May.

Comments: GCBC outing. Birded the East Bay loop, then from Spanco to the West Bay obs deck, across Woodie Walk to view the nesting Pronthonotaries, then around the North Slough, and across the Reedy River Bridge. Temperatures in the 70s. 100% cloud cover until mid morning. Humid.

Hooded Merganser 1 First seen trying to enter a Wood Duck box in the East Bay. When that failed the bird swam to a downed tree at the edge of the lake and perched there alongside Wood Ducks. Female. Overall grayish brown with pale belly. Shaggy brown crest. Late bird for Conestee and first one reported there in any month of May.
